**SKILL LEVEL**  INTERMEDIATE

#### FINISHED SIZES

Instructions given fit size small; changes for large are in [ ].

#### FINISHED MEASUREMENTS

**Above thumb:** 5–6-inch hand (*small*)  
[7–8-inch hand (*large*)]

#### MATERIALS

- Plymouth Encore Tweed medium (worsted) weight yarn (3½ oz/200 yds/100g per skein):



- 1 ball #4108 denim
- Size G/6/4mm crochet hook or size needed to obtain gauge
- Tapestry needle
- Stitch marker

#### GAUGE

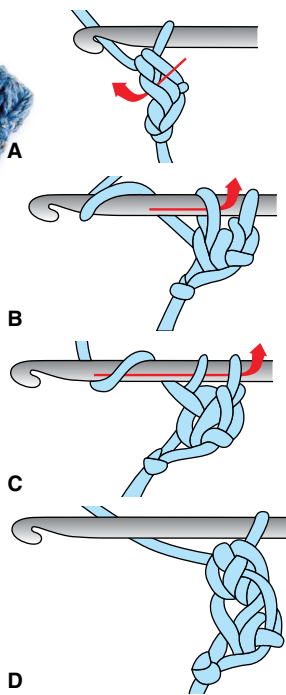
14 sc = 4 inches; 16 sc rows = 4 inches

#### PATTERN NOTES

Work in continuous rounds, do not turn or join unless otherwise stated.

Mark first stitch of each round.

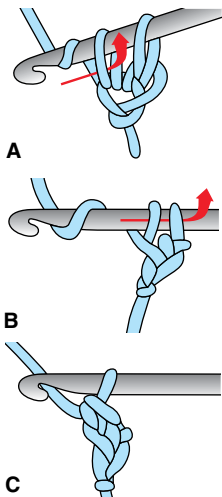
Join with slip stitch as indicated unless otherwise stated.



Next Foundation Single Crochet

#### SPECIAL STITCHES

**First foundation single crochet (first foundation sc):** Ch 2, insert hook into 2nd ch from hook, yo, pull up lp, yo, pull through 1 lp on hook (*ch-1 completed*), yo, pull through all lps on hook (*sc completed*).



First Foundation Single Crochet

**Next foundation single crochet (next foundation sc):** [Insert hook in ch-1 made, yo, pull up lp, yo, pull through 1 lp on hook (*ch-1*), yo, pull through all lps on hook (*sc*)] as indicated in instructions.

**7-spike stitch (7-spike st):** \*Insert hook in same st just worked in, pull up lp, insert hook in st 1 row below, pull up lp, insert hook in st 2 rows below, pull up lp, insert hook in next st 3 rows below, pull up lp, insert hook in next st 2 rows below, pull up lp, insert hook in st 1 row below, pull up lp, insert hook in next st on this row, pull up lp, yo, pull through all lps on hook, ch 1 to close.

#### HAND WARMER

Make 2.

##### Ribbing

**Foundation row: First foundation sc** (see *Special Stitches*), 10 **next foundation sc** (see *Special Stitches*), turn. (11 sc)

**Rows 1–20 [1–27]:** Ch 1, sc in both lps of first st, sc in **back lp** across to last st, sc in both lps of last st, turn.

**Row 21 [28]:** Ch 1, sc in both lps of first st, sc in back lps of each st across to last

st, sc in both lps of last st, turn work clockwise.

#### Hand

**Rnd 1:** Now working in rnds, ch 1, sc in end of each row across, **join** (see *Pattern Notes*) in beg sc. (22 [29] sc)

**Rnd 2:** Ch 1, sc in each st around, **do not join** (see *Pattern Notes*), **mark first st of rnd** (see *Pattern Notes*).

**Rnd 3:** 2 sc in first st, sc in each st around, ending with 2 sc in last st. (24 [31] sc)

**Rnd 4:** Sc in each of first 11 [14] sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, sc in each of last 11 [15] sts. (26 [33] sc)

**Rnd 5:** 2 sc in first st, sc in each st around, ending with 2 sc in last st. (28 [35] sc)

**Rnd 6:** 2 sc in first st, sc in each of next 12 [15] sts, 2 sc in each of next 2 sts, [sc in each of next 12 [16] sts, 2 sc in last st. (32 [39] sc)

**Rnd 7:** 2 sc in first st, sc in each st around, ending with 2 sc in last st. (34 [41] sc)

**Rnd 8:** 2 sc in first st, sc in each st around, ending with 2 sc in last st. (36 [43] sc)

**Rnd 9:** Sc in each of first 4 sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each of next 26 [33] sts, 2 sc in next st, sc in each of last 4 sts. (38 [45] sc)

**Rnd 10 (thumb hole):** Sc in each of first 6 [7] sts, sk next 26 [31] sts, sc in each of last 6 [7] sts. (12 [14] sc)

**Rnd 11:** Sl st in each of first 6 [7] sts, 2 sc in same st on rnd 9 as last st of thumb, sc in each of next 26 [31] sk sts on rnd 9, 2 [1] sc in same st on rnd 9 as thumb. (30 [34] sc)

**Rnds 12–17:** Sc in each st around.

**Rnd 18:** **7-spike st** (see *Special Stitches*) around. (15 [17] 7-spike sts)

**Rnd 19:** Sc in each st around, join in beg sc. Fasten off.

#### Finishing

Turn piece inside out, sew first and last rows of Ribbing tog.

Turn right side out. **C!**
