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Cute-as-a-Button Baby Set

Skill Level  **EASY**

Sizes

Jacket: Newborn (3–6 months,
6–9 months)

Hat: Small/medium (medium/large)

Booties: Small/medium (medium/large)

Instructions are given for smallest size,
with larger sizes in parentheses. When
only 1 number is given, it applies to
all sizes.

Finished Measurements

Jacket chest: 19¼ (21¼, 24¼) inches
(buttoned)

Jacket length: 10 (11, 12) inches

Hat circumference: 14 (16) inches

Foot length: 4 (5) inches

Materials

- DK weight yarn* (115 yds/
50g per ball): 4 (5, 5) balls
lilac #719
- Size 6 (4 mm) double-point (set of 5)
and 16-inch circular needles or size
needed to obtain gauge
- 5 (½-inch) buttons
- 1 yd ribbon for booties (optional)

Gauge

17 sts and 32 rows = 4 inches/
10cm in Eyelet Lace pat (after
blocking).

19 sts and 27 rows = 4 inches/
10cm in St st.

To save time, take time to
check gauge.

Special Abbreviation

**Knit in front and back of stitch
(k1f&b):** K1 in front and back of st
to inc 1.

Pattern Stitch

Eyelet Lace (multiple of 3 sts + 3)

Row 1 and all WS rows: Purl.

Row 2 (RS): K2, *k2tog, yo, k1; rep
from * to last st, k1.

Row 4: K2, *yo, k1, k2tog; rep from *
to last st, k1.

Rep Rows 1–4 for pat.

Pattern Note

When knitting hat, change to double-
point needles when stitches no longer
fit comfortably on circular needle.

Jacket Back

Cast on 42 (45, 51) sts.

Knit 5 rows.

Work in Eyelet Lace pat until piece
measures 10 (11, 12) inches, ending
with a RS row.

Bind off pwise.

Right Front

Cast on 18 (21, 24) sts.

Knit 5 rows.

Work in Eyelet Lace pat until piece
measures 8½ (9, 10) inches, ending
with a WS row.

Neck shaping

With RS facing, continue in pat and
bind off 2 sts at neck edge [every RS
row] 1 (2, 3) times—16 (17, 18) sts.

Bind off 1 st at neck edge [every RS
row] 3 times—13 (14, 15) sts.

Work even in pat until piece
measures same as back, ending with
a RS row.

Bind off pwise.

Left Front

Work as for right front to neck
shaping, ending with a RS row.

Neck shaping

With WS facing, continue in pat and
bind off 2 sts at neck edge [every WS
row] 1 (2, 3) times—16 (17, 18) sts.

Bind off 1 st at neck edge [every
WS row] 3 times—13 (14, 15) sts.

Work even in pat until piece
measures same as back, ending
with a RS row.

Bind off pwise.

Sleeves

Cast on 28 (30, 30) sts.



Knit 5 rows.
Inc row (RS): K1, k1f&b, knit to last 2 sts, k1f&b, k1—30 (32, 32 sts).

Continue in St st and rep Inc row [every 4 rows] 8 (9, 11) times—46 (50, 54) sts.

Work even until piece measures 6½ (7, 8) inches.

Bind off.

Finishing

Weave in all ends. Block pieces. Sew shoulder seams. Mark armholes by placing markers 4¾ (5¼, 5½) inches down from shoulders on fronts and back. Sew sleeves between markers. Sew side and sleeve seams.

Neck edging

With RS facing, pick up and knit 47 (49, 57) sts around neck.

Knit 3 rows.

Bind off pwise on RS.

Buttonhole band

With RS facing, pick up and knit 42 (46, 48) sts along appropriate front edge (right side for girl's jacket, left side for boy's jacket) between cast-on edge and neck edging.

Knit 3 rows.

Buttonhole row: K2 (2, 4), *yo, k2tog, k7 (8, 8); rep from * to last 4 sts, yo, k2tog, k2.

Knit 3 rows.

Bind off kwise on WS.

Button band

With RS facing, pick up and knit 42 (46, 48) sts along opposite front edge.

Knit 8 rows.

Bind off kwise on WS.



Hat Body

Using dpns or short circular needle, cast on 60 (66) sts; place marker for beg of rnd and join, taking care not to twist sts.

Rnds 1, 3, 5: Purl

Rnds 2, 4, 6: Knit.

Rnd 7: *K2tog, yo, k1; rep from * around.

Rnd 8: Knit.

Rnd 9: *Yo, k1, k2tog; rep from * around.

Rep Rnds 6–9 until hat measures 4 (4½) inches.

Shape crown


Rnd 1: *K4, k2tog; rep from * around—50 (55) sts.

Rnd 2 and all even-number rnds: Purl.

Rnds 3 and 5: Knit.

Rnd 7: *K3, k2tog; rep from * around—40 (44) sts.

Rnd 9: Knit.



Rnd 11: *K2, k2tog; rep from * around—30 (33) sts.

Rnd 13: *K4, k2tog; rep from * to last 0 (3) sts, k0 (3)—25 (28) sts.

Rnd 15: *K3, k2tog; rep from * last 0 (3) sts, k0 (3)—20 (23) sts.

Rnd 17: *K2, k2tog; rep from * around—15 (18) sts.

Rnd 19: *K1, k2tog; rep from * around—10 (12) sts.

Rnd 21: *K2tog; rep from * around—5 (6) sts.

Cut yarn leaving a 6-inch tail. With tapestry needle, thread tail through rem sts, pull tight and secure to WS.

Booties Cuff/Heel

Cast on 27 (33) sts.

Knit 4 rows.

Beg with Row 2, work 11 (15) rows in Eyelet Lace pat.

Next row (RS): K18 (22) sts, turn, leaving rem sts unworked.

Next row: K9 (11) sts, turn, leaving rem sts unworked.

Working on center 9 (11) sts, knit 12 (16) rows.

Next row (RS): K9 (11), pick up and knit 7 (9) sts along left side of flap, knit across rem 9 (11) sts, turn—25 (31) sts.

Next row: K25 (31), pick up and knit 7 (9) sts along right side of flap then knit rem 9 (11) sts—41 (51) sts.

Shape foot

Row 1 (RS): K1, k2tog, k15 (19), k2tog, k1 (3), k2tog, k15

(19), k2tog, k1—37 (47) sts.

Rows 2 and 4: Knit.

Row 3: K1, k2tog, k13 (18), k2tog, k1, k2tog, k13 (18), k2tog, k1—33 (43) sts.

Row 5: K1, k2tog, k11 (16), k2tog, k1, k2tog, k11 (16), k2tog, k1—29 (39) sts.

Bind off
kwise on WS.
Cut yarn,
leaving a long
tail.

Finishing

Sew seam from
toe/sole to
top cuff.

Optional: Thread
ribbon through eye-
lets closest to
foot and tie
in bow. ■



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
